

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING ARTICLES OF PARTICIPATION:

1. This parade is in honor of veterans - All veterans, actively serving military personnel, and veteran service organizations (American Legion, DAV, VFW, etc.) are encouraged to participate – Veterans will lead the parade down Pine Avenue and be recognized at a brief ceremony at City Pier Park after the parade.
2. We invite participation from area civic organizations (Exchange, Kiwanis, Lions, Rotary, etc.), school and youth groups, local businesses, marching bands and drumlines, dance and sports teams, and any others interested in participating in keeping with the spirit of the day.
3. Participants are welcome to walk or march and/or drive vehicles or floats.
4. The parade leaves Anna Maria City Hall at 1 pm. It will proceed down Pine Avenue ending at City Pier Park where a short ceremony will honor veterans.
5. All floats and units will be assigned a staging area and must be staged by 12:30 pm on November 11, 2022.
6. Application must be SIGNED and turned in by November 4, 2022. **ENTRY IS FREE.**
7. Float or car must be decorated in colors and style befitting the spirit of the holiday or event.
8. The use of water guns/cannons, water balloons, etc. or throwing of hard or sharp objects is not allowed.
9. All units should have a sign or banner indicating who they represent.
10. **No political or protest signs or displays are allowed.**
11. The City of Anna Maria in no way assumes liability for another organization or participant who is in the parade.
12. The firing of black powder is allowed by the AMI Privateers ONLY.
13. All units may be on foot, motorized or peddled; marching or walking units can be accommodated.
14. No person or organization may charge a fee or request a donation to be on any float or to participate.
15. The City of Anna Maria reserves the right to refuse participation in the parade by any entry which is, in the estimation of Management, not in keeping with the theme of the event or refuses to sign this form.
